

Classes for refugees at the TAS

You had to leave your home country? You have just recently arrived in Germany? You want to learn and get a German school - leaving qualification? You are between 16 and 30 years of age?

TAS offers you various ways to start learning.

Many young people and younger adults from 55 different nations worldwide attend the TAS where their aim is to get a school -leaving qualification. Among them there are many who are refugees just like you.

TAS offers special preparatory classes for refugees; with these classes we can meet your needs and individual skills.

We offer our thanks to the financial support from HIT –foundation; it was possible with its help to set up preparatory classes which correspond to 4 different learning and language levels.

We start with a placement and diagnosis test to be sure to find the right learning level for you regarding language and skills.

The result of these tests decide about the length of your stay at the TAS. Once you are in the system, you can repeat classes or jump classes. The question is how long you need

- to learn the German language,
- to get to know German culture,
- to give you a brush up or improve your basic knowledge in Maths, English, Biology and Social Studies,
- to develop an idea and perspective for your life in Germany - life and profession.

Teachers and social workers who are strongly committed to their work will help you on your way; psychological advice is available in case you have special problems.

On top of that we will help you find a mini job; such a mini job is the prerequisite for your transition from the preparatory course to the 1. semester.
